## **CV Per Aniansson**

### **Per Aniansson, (born 1966)**

Mr. Aniansson has been engaged as manager in industry projects, business development, investments and commercialisation of early stage companies throughout his career. The companies have mainly been within the TIME, Med Tech, Biotech and renewable energy sector.

After finishing his MSc in engineering physics 1992, Mr. Aniansson gained five years of experience from management consulting, first at Accenture and then at Arthur D Little. He completed an MBA at INSEAD 1997 and shortly thereafter moved into finance and venture capital. He has since held investment and managerial roles in Venture Capital and Investment companies working actively with portfolio companies from an owner and board position. The last three years he has had roles as CEO in two Medtech/Biotech companies from early stage development into an international commercial phase.

Mr Aniansson is currently a partner in Havgul Clean energy AS with a special focus on developing new projects in Sweden, industrial partnerships and financing matters. He is also on the board of Colonix Medical Ltd, Star Syringe Ltd, Sampor AB.

2005-06 Mr. Aniansson stepped in as Advisor for the ICT team at Innovations Kapital, a Swedish Venture Capital company. Before this, 2001-04 Mr. Aniansson was engaged to set-up and manage the Nordic operations for Siemens Mobile Acceleration, the corporate Venture Capital arm of Siemens Mobile. The operations were closed down as Siemens sold its Mobile business to BenQ 2004.

In 2000 Mr. Aniansson was hired to Icon Medialab to set up a Venture Capital company with a focus on IT and internet investments in Europe and the US.

In 1998 Mr. Aniansson joined Industrivärden with the explicit task to analyse and build an exposure in the Life Science industry. He was also responsible for the analysis and decision support regarding AGA, one of the core holdings, which was sold in 1999 to Linde AG.

During 1992-98 Mr. Aniansson held management consulting roles with Andersen Consulting and Arthur D. Little ranging from IT implementation and operations management to strategy and organisation. The projects were carried out across all the large industry sectors in Sweden.

Mr. Aniansson holds an M.Sc. degree in Engineering Physics from Chalmers University of Technology and an MBA from INSEAD. Mr. Aniansson's mother tongue is Swedish, he is fluent in English, can conduct business in French and German and has rudimentary understanding of Russian from studies at the Swedish Army Interpreter school.
